California General Education Pattern: IGETC

Students may satisfy ASU lower division general education requirements by completing the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC), including an additional laboratory science requirement. All courses must be satisfied with a "C" or better. IGETC must be fully certified by the student's California community college.

Note: ASU requires two semesters of lab science; a certified IGETC only requires one lab science. Students are encouraged to take the second lab science within IGETC Area 5 at their community college. If not completed prior to transfer, students will be required to fulfill the additional lab science requirement at ASU.
